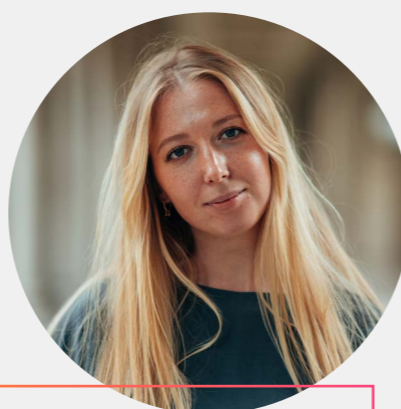

## Undergraduate – UK Pathways

### International Foundation

The International Foundation pathway is a stand-alone course, giving you a level 3 qualification equivalent to A-levels. Once you have completed this course you are able to progress on to undergraduate year 1 of a wide range of degrees.

### International Year Zero

The International Year Zero (IYZ) is an integrated course, which provides one year of preparation for undergraduate degree study. Once students have completed this year, they will continue to the first year of their chosen degree directly with the university.

### International Year One

The International Year One (IY1) is the equivalent to the first year of study at undergraduate level. Once you have completed this year, you will continue to the second year of your chosen degree directly with the university.

### International Stage One - Scotland

International Stage One (IS1) is the first year of a four-year Scottish undergraduate degree for international students. This course strengthens your English abilities and introduces key knowledge required in your chosen subject area; you will then continue to the second year of your chosen degree directly with the university.

### International Second Year

The International Second Year (ISY) is equivalent to the second-year level study of a three-year undergraduate degree. Once you have completed this year, you will continue to the third and final year of your chosen degree directly with the university.

### International Stage Two - Scotland

International Stage Two (IS2) is the second year of a four-year Scottish undergraduate degree for our international students. Once you have completed this pathway you will continue to the third year of your chosen degree directly with the University.

## Pre-Top Up in Business – DMU only

The Pre-Top Up (PTU) in Business is a top-up preparation course that provides international students a route to complete an undergraduate degree at De Montfort University.

## Undergraduate – US Pathway

### International Year One

The International Year One at Mercy or San Francisco State University allows international students to take credited General Education courses during your first year. You then enter directly into your second year with the university where you can begin to choose from a broad range of majors for your final degree.

## Postgraduate Pathway

### Pre-Master's

The Pre-Masters / International Incorporated Master's provides students with the advanced study skills and academic English support required for master's level study. This course can be studied over a number of terms depending on a student's academic qualifications and English language level.

## Pre-Sessional English

Our Pre-Sessional English courses provide an intensive training and assessment in the English language that lasts for either 6 or 12 weeks. The main objective of this academic English support is to improve your proficiency in the language, so that you can successfully pursue your desired pathway or degree program.

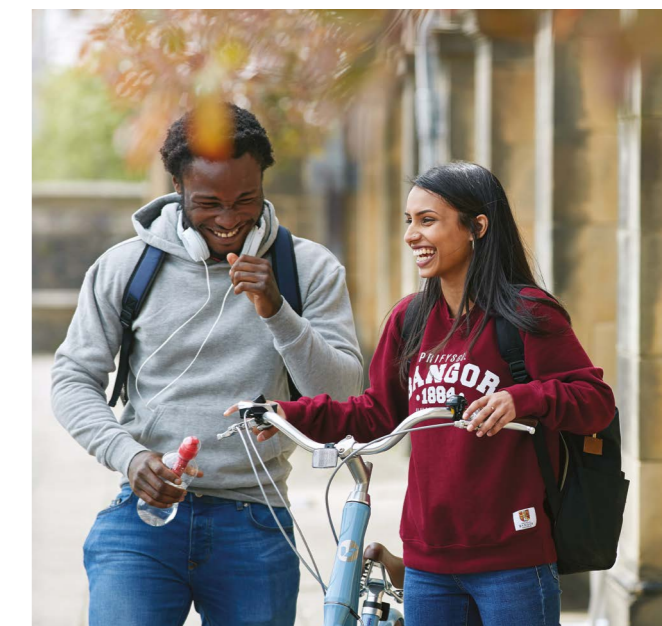

The flats are mostly en-suite and self-catered with shared kitchens and laundry facilities on site, and there is a choice of mixed or same-gender flats available.

Rent prices can range from £99 per week for a standard non en-suite room to £191 per week for a studio. The city centre train station is just five minutes' walk from campus, as well as a local airport.
