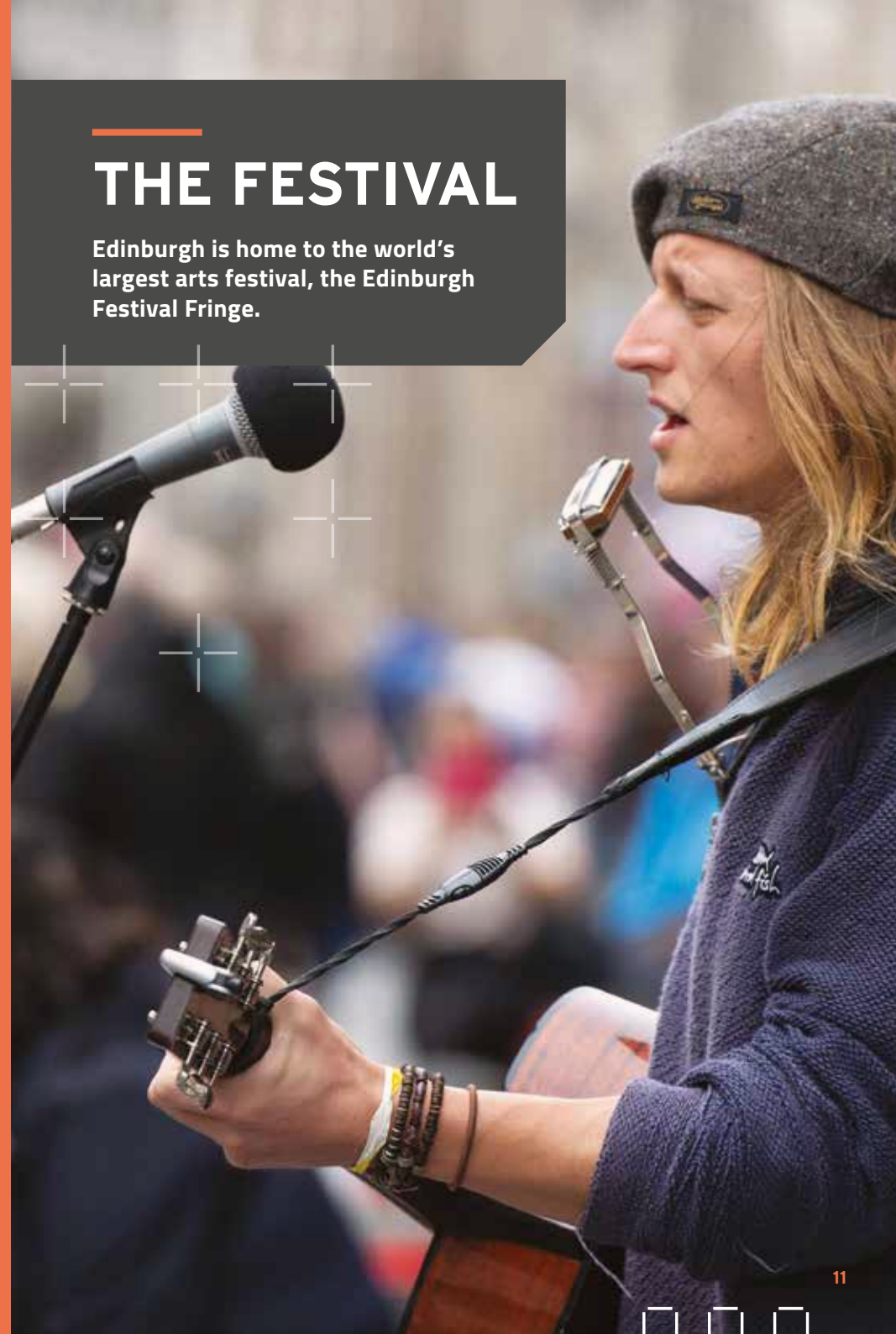

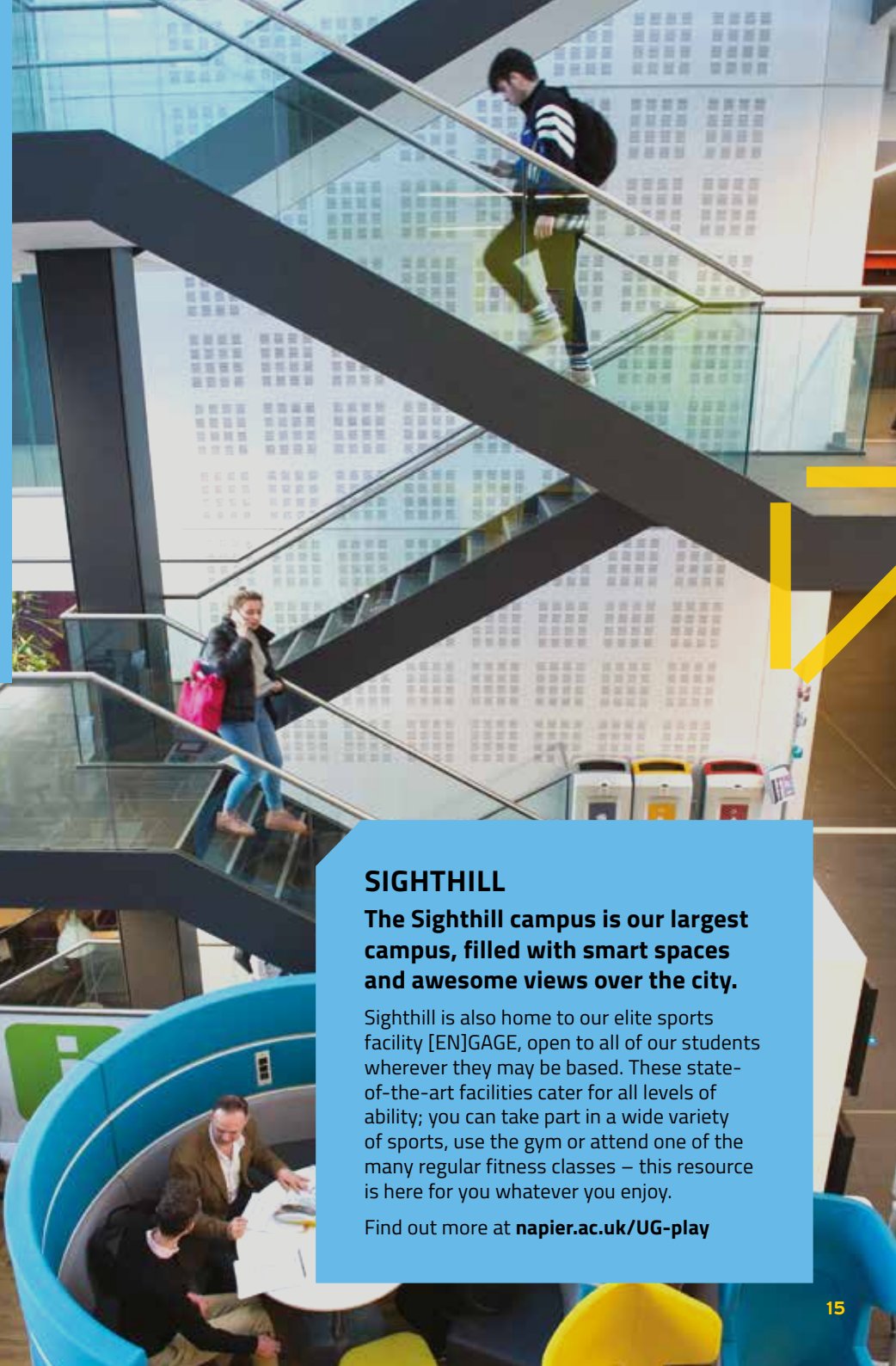
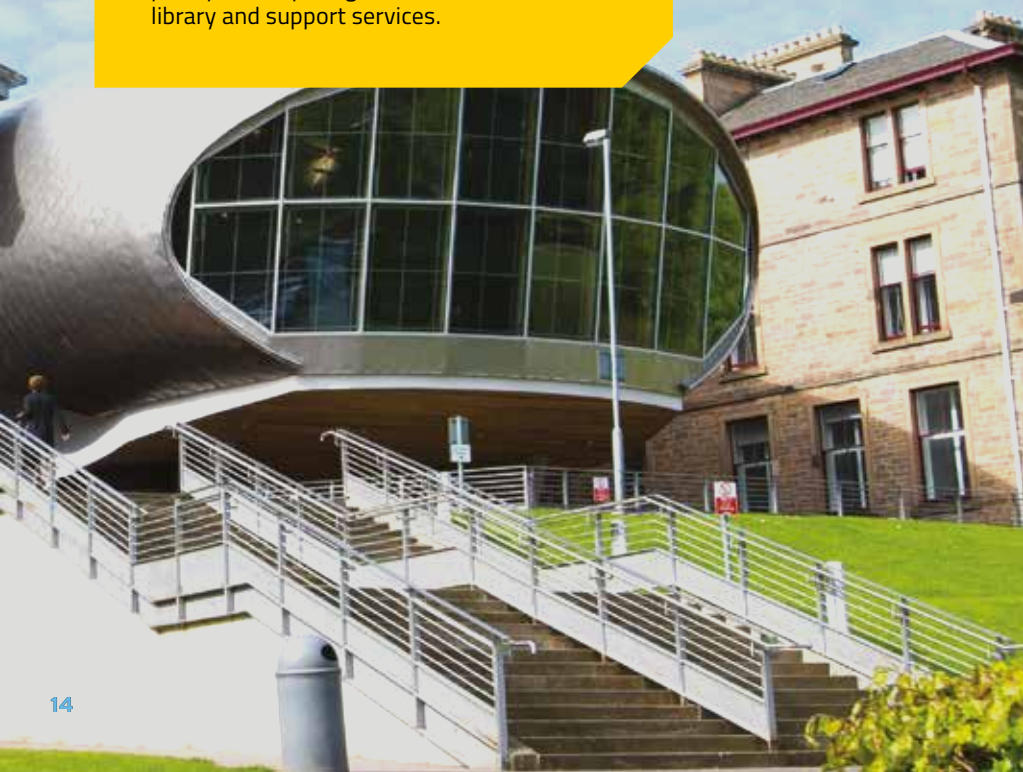
OTHER CAMPUSES

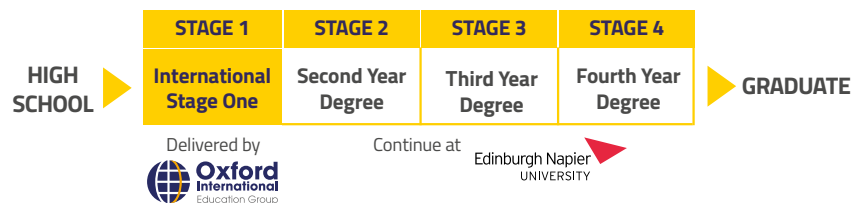
We have two undergraduate pathways for students to choose from depending on their English language and academic skill level.

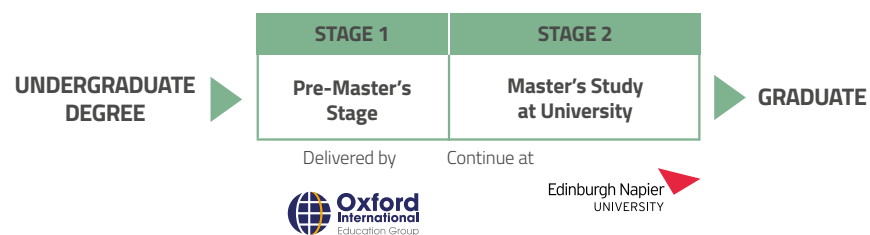
INTERNATIONAL INCORPORATED MASTERS

The IIM is offered over one or two terms and focuses on equipping you with the academic and English language skills you need to complete your postgraduate study at the Edinburgh Napier University.

After successfully completing the IIM programme you will continue onto your chosen postgraduate degree course at Edinburgh Napier University.

It is designed for students who do not qualify for direct entry to the master's programmes at the University, this could be because of the grades achieved in your bachelor's degree; your current qualifications are not equivalent to a UK bachelor's degree or because you have a different background.

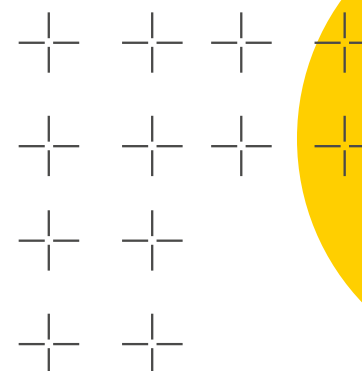
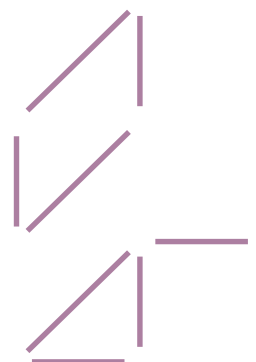

What happens after you submit your application?

STAGE 1: CHECK QUALIFICATIONS
